Day Camp Counsellor Job Description:

- Supervise, assist facilitators and volunteers and actively participate in all aspects of the campers' day, including:
 - Supervise campers during snacks/meals periods and drop off/ pick up periods;
 - Prepare for, organize and lead a variety of small and large group activities each week;
 - Take responsibility for the health, safety, well-being and happiness of campers;
 - Create a positive rapport with all campers and guide campers for success;
 - Know, enforce, and model all safety guidelines and Code of Conduct.
- Prepare for and actively participate in pre-camp training and weekly meetings.
- Help write and implement a weekly schedule for your camp group.
- Meet/communicate regularly with camp facilitator regarding updates and challenges.
- Participate in clean-up and set-up/organization at the end of each day/week.
- Communicate with parents about camper's experiences.
- Must have a strong desire to have fun and embrace the zany, creative side of STEAM!

Job Requirements:

- High school math + sciences curiosity about how things work, willingness to learn.
- High energy, self-starter.
- Desire to work with children and youth.
- Excellent people skills and friendly responsible service-oriented attitude.
- Strong communication and teamwork abilities; Able to problem-solve effectively.
- Fluency in English.
- Ability to stand for extended period times, mobility to bend, twist, lift arms above head and travel distances (between lab and outside open spaces), lift up to 25 lbs.

- At least 15 years of age.
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident and legally entitled to work and study in Canada.

- Must be enrolled in a program which will result in a credential (degree, diploma, certificate).
